
Here is the brief for Friday 29 January 2021.

COVID-19 vaccination programme Effective immediately, any staff based at Foresterhill and Roxburghe House making a **new request** for COVID-19 vaccination should use the <u>Aberdeen City form</u>. All new booked appointments for this staff group will take place at P&J Live at TECA.

If you had your first appointment at the ARI clinic, your second appointment will take place there as scheduled. Peer vaccination, and the arrangements for staff in Moray and Aberdeenshire are unchanged.

Vaccine development You will have likely seen or heard coverage today of further vaccine developments. The Novavax vaccine – being trialled here in Grampian, amongst other centres – is showing more than 89% efficacy, with significant results against emerging variants of COVID-19. You can read more about that <u>here</u>. Particular thanks must go to all the local staff – and of course the volunteers – supporting the Novavax trial in Aberdeen. Meanwhile, a single dose vaccine developed by Janssen is 66% effective overall in trials – more information <u>here</u>. Neither vaccine has currently reached the final approval stage, but the UK has submitted pre-orders for both products, in the event that they are cleared for use.
