Agenda for Change Pay Award As confirmed at the end of December, the 2022/23 pay award will be applied in January salaries. Staff who are paid monthly will receive the uplift in their salary on 26 January; weekly paid bank workers will have seen the increase applied from last Friday.

We know everyone is keen to understand when backdated pay will be received. At this point in time all Payroll teams across NHS Scotland have confirmed they are on track to pay arrears in February. Monthly paid staff will receive this on 28 February, whilst weekly paid bank workers will see their arrears being paid Friday 24 February.
